INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 565-Representative Fende.

Cosponsors: Representatives Domenick, Okey, Harwood.

To amend sections 4507.164 and 4511.203 of the Revised Code to prohibit a person from entrusting a motor vehicle to a person whom the entruster knows or has reasonable cause to believe is subject to pending OVI or OVUAC charges and to provide that the penalty for a violation of that prohibition or the existing prohibitions related to entrustment of a motor vehicle to a person whose driver's license is suspended under the Implied Consent Law or who is intoxicated is a felony of the fifth degree with a Class 6 judicial license suspension if the other person's act of driving the vehicle caused the death of another.

Said bill was considered the first time.
