**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 566**-Representative Murray.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hagan, Harris, Evans, Gardner, Pillich, McGregor, Walter, Lundy, Slesnick, Skindell, Letson, Chandler, Stebelton.

To amend section 309.09 of the Revised Code to make clear that the prosecuting attorney of a county is the legal adviser of all tax-supported public libraries.

**H. B. No. 567**-Representative Boyd.

To amend sections 3701.901, 3701.903, 4742.03, 4765.10, 4765.16, and 4765.40 and to enact sections 3701.908, 3701.909, 3727.11, 4765.44, and 4765.441 of the Revised Code to provide for recognition of hospital primary stroke centers and establishment of protocols for emergency triage, treatment, and transport of stroke patients.

Said bills were considered the first time.
