INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 569-Representative Sears.

Cosponsors: Representatives Wachtmann, Evans, Stebelton, Adams, R., Adams, J.

To amend sections 5747.98 and 5751.98 and to enact sections 3746.241, 5747.78, and 5751.54 of the Revised Code to authorize refundable tax credits through 2015 for the completion of a voluntary action to remediate a contaminated site and for the return of such sites to productive use, and to exempt persons through 2015 who have been issued covenants not to sue under the Voluntary Action Program from certain fees and penalties for one year after the issuance of such a covenant.

H. B. No. 570-Representative Grossman.

To amend sections 955.04, 955.21, and 955.99 and to enact sections 956.01 to 956.11 and 956.99 of the Revised Code to establish standards of care for commercial dog breeding kennels and to establish requirements governing the sale of dogs.

H. B. No. 571-Representative Uecker.

Cosponsors: Representatives Jordan, Maag, Snitchler, Zehringer, Martin, Beck, Sears, Wachtmann, Ruhl, Boose, Adams, J., Stebelton, Goodwin, Morgan, Derickson, Blair, Wagner, Bulp, Adams, R., Grossman, Okey, Dyer, O'Farrell, Combs, Garland, Mecklenborg, Pillich, Phillips, Patten, Hall.

To amend section 2923.126 of the Revised Code to permit a concealed carry licensee who is an employee of a private employer to store the employee's handgun in a locked motor vehicle parked on premises owned or leased by the employer.

Said bills were considered the first time.
