INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 581-Representative Murray.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brown, Gardner, Celeste, Walter, Harwood, Evans, Boose, Stebelton, Yuko.

To request the Congressional Joint Committee on the Library of Congress to approve the replacement of Ohio's statue of Governor William Allen in the National Statuary Hall Collection with a statue of Thomas Edison.

H. B. No. 582-Representatives Burke, Bubp.

To amend sections 4729.75, 4729.77, 4729.79, 4729.83, 4729.84, and 5111.172 and to enact sections 4729.791, 4729.821, 4729.831, 4731.055, 5111.179, and 5111.1710 of the Revised Code regarding the State Board of Pharmacy's drug database and a program for certain Medicaid recipients found to have over used items or services.

H. B. No. 583-Representative Batchelder.

Cosponsors: Representatives Adams, R., Blessing, Combs, Derickson, Grossman, Huffman, Beck.

To amend section 905.40; to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as indicated in parentheses, section 905.461 (905.411); and to enact section 905.41 of the Revised Code to establish requirements governing the design and construction of anhydrous ammonia storage facilities.
