INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 589-Representative Ruhl.

To enact section 5533.763 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of United States Route 62 in Knox County as the "Army Staff Sgt. Shamus O. Goare Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 590-Representative Koziura.

To enact sections 1315.41, 1315.42, and 1315.43 of the Revised Code to require that certain disclosures be made to consumers who apply for a refund anticipation loan.

Said bills were considered the first time.
