INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 616-Representative Hagan.

Cosponsors: Representatives Foley, Skindell.

To amend sections 124.82, 5747.11, and 5747.15 and to enact sections 124.824 and 5747.075 of the Revised Code to allow individuals to purchase the same health plan offered to state employees and to fund the foregoing by levying a tax on employers based on the employer's payroll.

H. B. No. 617-Representative O'Farrell.

To amend sections 122.17, 5725.98, 5729.98, 5733.98, 5747.98, and 5751.98 and to enact section 122.175 of the Revised Code to authorize refundable tax credits to foster job creation and capital investment in the Ohio Appalachian Region.

Said bills were considered the first time.
