**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 238**-Senator Seitz.

Cosponsors: Senators Grendell, Cates, Stewart, Jones, Niehaus, Schaffer, Gibbs, Schuring, Buehrer, Hughes.

To amend sections 2743.02, 2744.02, 4123.01, and 4123.511 and to enact sections 2307.82, 4123.513, 4123.514, and 4123.515 of the Revised Code to prohibit illegal and unauthorized aliens from receiving compensation and benefits under Ohio's Workers' Compensation Law.

**S. B. No. 239**-Senators Jones, Schaffer.

Cosponsors: Senators Buehrer, Carey, Cafaro, Faber, Gibbs, Grendell, Husted, Niehaus, Seitz, Wagoner.

To amend sections 2923.121, 2923.128, and 2923.16 of the Revised Code to permit a concealed carry licensee to possess a firearm in liquor permit premises, or an open air arena, for which a D permit has been issued if the licensee is not consuming liquor or under the influence of alcohol or a drug of abuse and to modify the offense of improperly handling firearms in a motor vehicle as it applies to concealed carry licensees.

**S. B. No. 240**-Senator Husted.

Cosponsors: Senators Grendell, Wagoner, Jones.

To amend sections 3517.01, 3517.105, 3517.1011, 3517.13, 3517.992, 3599.03, 5727.61, and 5733.27 of the Revised Code to permit domestic corporations and labor organizations to make independent expenditures and electioneering communications in support of or opposition to candidates for nomination or election and to require a domestic corporation or labor organization that makes such expenditures to file related campaign finance statements.
