**REPORTS OF REFERENCE AND BILLS FOR SECOND
CONSIDERATION**

Senator Schuler reports for the Standing Committee on Reference, recommending that the following bills and resolution, standing in order for second consideration, be referred to committee as recommended:

S. B. No. 82-Senator Niehaus, et al.

To amend sections 4303.03 and 4303.182 and to enact section 4303.031 of the Revised Code to create the A-2a permit to authorize the sale of wine at retail by an A-2 permit holder at a location other than the premises where the wine is manufactured.

To the Committee on Agriculture.

S. B. No. 83-Senator Faber.

To amend section 145.01 and to enact section 145.016 of the Revised Code to exclude certain compensation when determining retirement benefits under the Public Employees Retirement System.

To the Committee on Health, Human Services and Aging.

S. R. No. 21-Senators Morano, Schiavoni, et al.

To encourage the use of federal economic recovery funds to promote goods and services made or performed by American citizens and companies.

To the Committee on Finance and Financial Institutions.

INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 84-Senator Wagoner.

Cosponsors: Senators Faber, Hughes, Morano.

To enact section 4513.264 of the Revised Code to require all buses purchased, leased, rented, or chartered by universities and colleges to transport students or employees to be equipped with occupant restraining devices for all passengers, to permit buses that currently are owned by universities and colleges and are not equipped with occupant restraining devices for all passengers to shuttle students or employees indefinitely, and to permit such buses to transport students or employees on trips other than shuttle trips for a period of three years before such buses are required to be equipped with occupant restraining devices for all passengers.

S. B. No. 85-Senator Stewart.

Cosponsor: Senator Seitz.

To enact sections 9.29, 6101.161, 6103.101, 6115.201, and 6119.101 of the Revised Code to authorize certain political subdivisions to contract for engineering, repair, sustainability, water quality management, and maintenance of a water storage tank through a professional service contract under specified conditions.
