Senator Seitz offered the following joint resolution:

S. J. R. No. 10-Senator Seitz.

Cosponsors: Senators Wagoner, Cates, Grendell, Miller, D., Patton, Goodman, Miller, R., Sawyer.

Proposing to amend Section 6 of Article IV and to repeal Sections 19 and 22 of Article IV of the Constitution of Ohio to change the age at and after which a person may not be elected or appointed to a judicial office and to eliminate the authority of the General Assembly to establish courts of conciliation and to reappoint a Supreme Court commission.

The question being, "Shall the joint resolution, **S. J. R. No. 10**, be adopted?"

On the motion of Senator Gillmor, **S. J. R. No. 10**, was referred to the Committee on Reference.
