To amend section 2108.31 of the Revised Code to permit persons who are sixteen to donate blood with parental consent.

To the Committee on State and Local Government and Veterans' Affairs.

S. B. No. 87-Senator Wagoner, et al.

To enact section 5.2265 of the Revised Code to designate March 29 as "Vietnam War Veterans' Day."
