INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 251-Senators Seitz, Schiavoni.

Cosponsor: Senator Turner.

To amend sections 1337.092, 1337.12, 2101.24, 2109.21, 2111.02, 2111.12, 2111.121, 5301.071, 5747.02, 5801.10, 5808.14, 5808.17, and 5810.13; to enact new section 2107.52 and sections 1337.21 to 1337.64, 3793.31 to 3793.39, 5808.18, 5808.19, 5809.031, and 5810.14; and to repeal sections 1337.09, 1337.091, 1337.093, 1337.18, 1337.19, 1337.20, and 2107.52 of the Revised Code to adopt the Uniform Power of Attorney Act; to modify a trustee's duties with respect to life insurance policies, specify a trustee's power to distribute trust principal in further trust, provide for the titling of assets in trust form, and make other changes in the Trust Code; to modify the anti-lapse provisions regarding wills and adopt anti-lapse provisions applicable to trusts; and to provide a mechanism for a probate court to order a person who suffers from alcohol and other drug abuse to undergo treatment.
