INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 284-Senator Kearney.

To amend section 5512.04 and to enact sections 122.09 and 166.051 of the Revised Code to require the Director of Development and the Transportation Review Advisory Council, when considering project incentive awards, to provide a point preference to projects located within two miles of a Center of Excellence in Higher Education or located in Ohio Hubs of Innovation and Opportunity or Heritage Ohio Main Street Program communities.
