The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 158-Senator Miller, R.

To enact section 4743.04 of the Revised Code to require certain health care professionals to complete instruction in cultural competency.

S. B. No. 159-Senator Miller, R.

To enact sections 1751.76, 3923.651, and 3923.74 of the Revised Code to prohibit health insurers from denying payment for a service during or after the performance of the service if the insurer provided prior written authorization for the service.
