INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 305-Senator Hughes.

Cosponsors: Senators Goodman, Stewart, Seitz, Turner, Smith.

To amend section 5747.113 and to enact section 173.041 of the Revised Code to allow taxpayers to contribute a portion of their income tax refunds to the Alzheimer's Association.

S. B. No. 306-Senator Kearney.

To amend section 5139.03 of the Revised Code to require all meals served in institutions or facilities under the control of the Department of Youth Services to conform with the Dietary Guidelines for Americans jointly developed by the United States Department of Agriculture and the United States Department of Health and Human Services.
