INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 179-Senators Grendell, Schaffer.

Cosponsors: Senators Harris, Seitz, Miller, D., Stewart.

To enact section 121.531 of the Revised Code to prohibit spending American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 funds on signs that identify the source of specific project funding and to declare an emergency.

S. B. No. 180-Senator Husted.

Cosponsors: Senators Goodman, Wagoner, Harris, Jones, Schaffer, Cates.

To amend sections 3314.013, 3314.014, 3314.016, 3314.02, 3314.021, 3314.03, 3314.05, 3319.22, 3319.223, and 3319.61 and to enact section 3319.227 of the Revised Code to allow new Internet- or computer-based community schools to open under certain conditions, to require the use of student performance data in evaluating teachers and principals for licensure, and to qualify Teach for America participants for a professional educator license.
