INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 308-Senator Schuring.

Cosponsors: Senators Stewart, Sawyer, Miller, D., Fedor.

To enact section 3319.80 of the Revised Code to authorize educational service centers to provide teacher professional development on dyslexia.

S. B. No. 309-Senator Miller, R.

To amend section 3702.31 and to enact sections 3701.94 and 3701.941 of the Revised Code to prohibit clinical laboratory services providers from inducing physicians to refer patients in exchange for remuneration and from placing laboratory personnel in physician offices.
