The Senate met pursuant to adjournment.

The journal of the last legislative day was read and approved.

BILLS FOR THIRD CONSIDERATION

Sub. S. B. No. 117 -Senators Miller, D., Coughlin. Cosponsors: Senators Turner, Strahorn, Miller, R., Smith, Schuler, Schiavoni, Morano.

To enact section 5.2239 of the Revised Code to designate the month of May as "Multiple Chemical Sensitivity Awareness Month", having been informally passed, was taken up.

The question being, "Shall the bill, Sub. S. B. No. 117, pass?"

On the motion of Senator Carey, **Sub. S. B. No. 117** was informally passed and retained its place on the calendar.

INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 312-Senator Patton.

To enact section 5533.353 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of Pearl Road within Cuyahoga County as the "Lance Corporal David Mendez Ruiz Memorial Highway."

OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS

Senator Harris offered the following joint resolution:

S. J. R. No. 12-Senators Harris, Cafaro.

To provide for the Ohio General Assembly to meet in joint session at the Franklin County Veterans Memorial on November 10, 2010, for the purpose of honoring the recipients of the Ohio Military Medal of Distinction and their family members.

WHEREAS, Am. Sub. S.B. 248 of the 127th General Assembly established the Ohio Military Medal of Distinction to honor Ohioans who have fallen while in the service of the United States; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio General Assembly intends to honor the nearly 200 recipients of the Ohio Military Medal of Distinction in a joint session of the

General Assembly convened for that purpose; and

WHEREAS, It is appropriate to conduct that joint session at the Franklin County Veterans Memorial, the core mission of which is "to commemorate the services of all members and veterans of the armed forces of the United States"; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 128th General Assembly of the state of Ohio, shall meet in joint session at the Franklin County Veterans Memorial at 300 West Broad Street, Columbus, on Wednesday, November 10, 2010, at 1:00 o'clock p.m., for the purpose of honoring the recipients of the Ohio Military Medal of Distinction and their family members.

The question being, "Shall the joint resolution, **S. J. R. No. 12**, be adopted?"

So the joint resolution was adopted.

The question being, "Shall the title be agreed to?"

The title was agreed to.

Pursuant to Senate Rule No. 54, the following resolution was offered:

S. R. No. 313-Senator Harris.

Honoring Chief Philip Messer on his retirement from the Mansfield Division of Police.
