### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

### H. B. No. 411-Representative Luckie.

To enact section 3345.35 of the Revised Code to authorize stipends for student athletes attending public and private, nonprofit colleges and universities.

### H. B. No. 412-Representatives Antonio, Carney.

To amend sections 124.14 and 3924.01 and to enact sections 3965.01 to 3965.14 of the Revised Code to establish the Ohio Health Benefit Exchange Agency and to establish the Ohio Health Benefit Exchange Program consisting of an exchange for individual coverage and a Small Business Health Options Program.

### H. B. No. 413-Representatives Goyal, Murray.

To amend sections 3501.05, 3517.16, and 5747.081 and to enact sections 3525.01 to 3525.11 and 3525.99 of the Revised Code to create a public campaign financing system for candidates for the office of chief justice or justice of the Supreme Court.

### H. B. No. 414-Representative Anielski.

To amend sections 2903.211 and 2917.21 of the Revised Code to expand the offenses of menacing by stalking and telecommunications harassment and to prohibit a person from knowingly causing another person to believe that the offender will cause physical harm or mental or emotional distress to the other person's immediate family.

### H. B. No. 415-Representatives Sprague, Hill.

To amend sections 135.631, 135.73, 135.74, and 135.75 of the Revised Code to modify the Agricultural Linked Deposit Program with respect to the maximum amount the Treasurer of State may invest in agricultural linked deposits, the interest rate at which loans are made under the Program, and the maximum loan amount.
