To amend sections 4903.083, 4905.302, 4906.06, 4909.05, 4909.06, 4909.07, 4909.08, 4909.15, 4909.156, 4909.17, 4909.18, 4909.19, 4928.18, 4929.05, 4929.051, 4929.11, and 4935.04 and to enact section 4929.111 of the Revised Code to permit certain rate-calculation adjustments for natural gas companies, eliminate public notice requirements for rate cases, and, for natural gas companies, to make other regulatory changes concerning audits, alternative rate plans, and forecast reports, and allowing applications for natural gas company capital expenditure programs.
