INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 460-Representative Patmon.

Cosponsors: Representatives Amstutz, Phillips, Barnes.

To amend section 4303.292 of the Revised Code to require the Division of Liquor Control to refuse to issue, renew, or transfer the ownership or location of a retail liquor permit if the applicant has violated the liquor control laws.

H. B. No. 461-Representative Stebelton.

Cosponsors: Representatives Adams, R., Gonzales, Grossman, Henne, McGregor, Okey, Yuko.

To amend section 3105.64 and to enact sections 3105.41, 3105.42, 3105.43, 3105.44, 3105.45, 3105.46, 3105.47, 3105.48, 3105.49, 3105.50, 3105.51, 3105.52, 3105.53, 3105.54, and 3105.55 of the Revised Code to establish a statutory collaborative family law process to aid in the resolution of family law disputes.

H. B. No. 462-Representative Pelanda.

Cosponsors: Representatives Boose, Garland, Pillich, Phillips, Hottinger, Milkovich, Blair, Stebelton, Yuko, Adams, J.

To amend section 3313.642 and to enact section 2151.272 of the Revised Code with respect to a school district's withholding or transfer to another district or school of the grades and credits of a child who is alleged or adjudicated an abused, neglected, or dependent child.

Said bills were considered the first time.
