INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 485-Representative Pelanda.

To amend sections 4723.43, 4723.44, 4729.01, and 4761.17 of the Revised Code to authorize certified registered nurse anesthetists to issue medication orders for the administration of drugs to patients during certain phases of patient care and to specify the circumstances in which such nurses may perform clinical support functions.

Said bill was considered the first time.
