**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 501**-Representatives Carney, Duffey.

To enact section 5.075 of the Revised Code to adopt the Adena Pipe as the official artifact of the state.

**H. B. No. 502**-Representative Martin.

To amend sections 319.301, 1545.21, 3316.041, 3316.06, 5705.03, 5705.2111, and 5705.412 and to repeal section 5705.192 of the Revised Code to eliminate the power of taxing authorities to propose a replacement property tax levy.

**H. B. No. 503**-Representative Ruhl.

To authorize the Board of County Commissioners of Knox County to establish the Centerburg Library as a county free public library and, if the authority is exercised, to require the Knox County Court of Common Pleas to appoint a board of library trustees for the library.

**H. B. No. 504**-Representative Huffman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Blair, Buchy, Cera, Derickson, Duffey, Stebelton, Terhar, Thompson.

To amend sections 3318.011 and 3318.36 of the Revised Code to revise the method for calculating school district equity rankings for classroom facilities assistance and to declare an emergency.

Said bills were considered the first time.

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 505**-Representative Amstutz.

To amend sections 5717.01, 5717.011, and 5717.02 and to enact section 5703.021 of the Revised Code to create a small claims division of the Ohio Board of Tax Appeals, to allow for parties to file a notice of appeal to the Board by facsimile or electronic transmission using electronic mail, to require the Board to establish a case management schedule for appeals, and to authorize the Tax Commissioner to expedite and issue a final determination for residential property value appeals with written consent of the parties.

**H. B. No. 506**-Representatives Williams, Amstutz.

To amend sections 124.36, 2903.13, 2921.02, 3302.03, 3302.04, 3302.061, 3307.01, 3311.71, 3311.72, 3311.74, 3311.76, 3313.41, 3313.411, 3313.975, 3314.012, 3314.016, 3314.10, 3314.35, 3314.36, 3316.07, 3318.08, 3319.02, 3319.071, 3319.10, 3319.112, 3319.12, 3319.13, 3319.14, 3319.141, 3319.143, 3319.151, 3319.18, 3319.283, 4141.29, 5705.192, 5705.21, 5705.212, 5705.215, 5705.216, 5705.218, 5705.261, and 5748.01 and to enact sections 3311.77 to 3311.86, 3313.412, 3314.351, and 4117.25 of the Revised Code to revise the management of municipal school districts and community schools located within municipal school districts; to require municipal school districts and unions to negotiate a new collective bargaining agreement as if no previous agreement existed for one bargaining cycle; to permit the establishment of a Municipal School District Transformation Alliance; to expand the offense of bribery to cover directors, officers, and employees of the Alliance; and to authorize municipal school districts to levy property taxes the revenue from which may be shared with qualifying community schools.

Said bills were considered the first time.
