To amend section 5751.98 and to enact section 5751.54 of the Revised Code to establish a nonrefundable commercial activity tax credit for companies involved in horizontal well drilling or related oil and gas production services that hire Ohio residents who have completed a federally registered apprenticeship program.

Said bill was considered the first time.
