**INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 580**-Representatives Combs, Lynch.

Cosponsors: Representatives Beck, Goodwin, Adams, J., Ruhl.

To enact section 2935.034 of the Revised Code relating to the verification of a person's immigration status by a peace officer or law enforcement agency.

**H. B. No. 581**-Representatives Lundy, Gerberry.

Cosponsors: Representatives Murray, Driehaus, Yuko, Winburn, Clyde, Garland, Boyd.

To amend sections 5739.02 and 5739.05 of the Revised Code to provide a two-day sales tax "holiday" each August during which sales of back-to-school clothing, school supplies, computers, and computer accessories are exempt from sales and use taxes.

Said bills were considered the first time.
