The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 582**-Representative Bulp.

To enact section 5533.741 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of the State Route 4 bypass in Butler County as the "Terry Dean Garrison Memorial Bypass."

**H. B. No. 583**-Representative Brenner.

Cosponsors: Representatives Bulp, Hottinger, Derickson, Thompson, Lynch.

To amend section 5747.01 of the Revised Code to provide an income tax deduction for the value of any prize or award won by a taxpayer in athletic competition in the Olympic Games.

Said bills were considered the first time.
