To enact section 5533.221 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 104 within Ross County as the "David A. Gibson Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 308-Representative Damschroder.

Cosponsors: Representatives Henne, Murray, Sprague, Peterson, Hackett, McGregor, Gonzales, Stebelton, Thompson, Slaby, Boose, Gardner.

To enact section 6133.041 of the Revised Code to authorize a joint board of county commissioners to conduct proceedings regarding existing joint county ditches via teleconference or video conference.
