INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 338-Representative Slesnick.

Cosponsors: Representatives Antonio, Ashford, Boyd, Celeste, Foley, Garland, Goyal, Hagan, R., Heard, Letson, Ramos, Stinziano, Yuko.

To amend sections 3313.60, 3313.6011, 3314.03, and 3326.11 of the Revised Code to establish statutory standards for comprehensive sexual health education and HIV/AIDS prevention education in public schools and to designate section 3313.6011 of the Revised Code as the "Act for Our Children's Future."

H. B. No. 339-Representative Patmon.

Cosponsors: Representatives Roegner, Stinziano, Ashford, Yuko, Ruhl, Stebelton, Weddington, Slaby, Brenner, Antonio.

To enact section 4503.732 of the Revised Code to create the "Birthplace of Superman" license plate.

H. B. No. 340-Representatives Patmon, Dovilla.

Cosponsors: Representatives Adams, J., Martin, Johnson, Damschroder, Ruhl, Fende, Slaby, Roegner.

To amend section 1533.32 of the Revised Code to specify that an applicant for a fishing license cannot be required to provide more than the last four digits of the applicant's Social Security number.

Said bills were considered the first time.
