The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 349-Representative McGregor.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hackett, Grossman, Murray.

To amend sections 3781.111, 4510.31, 4511.01, 4511.041, 4511.09, 4511.102, 4511.103, 4511.105, 4511.106, 4511.11, 4511.13, 4511.131, 4511.14, 4511.37, 4511.69, and 4955.33 and to repeal section 4511.15 of the Revised Code to make changes in certain provisions relating to road signs and traffic signals for purposes of the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
