INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 354-Representative Uecker.

Cosponsors: Representatives O'Brien, Lundy, Letson, Grossman, Gonzales, Brenner, Derickson, Reece, Blair, Combs.

To amend section 4503.546 of the Revised Code to redefine eligibility for issuance of a "Gold Star Family" license plate.

H. B. No. 355-Representative Blair.

Cosponsors: Representatives Boose, Brenner, Bulp, Baker, Damschroder, Letson, Young, Kozlowski.

To amend section 5747.113 of the Revised Code to allow taxpayers to contribute an amount to the state through their income tax returns and designate how the state must use the contribution.

H. B. No. 356-Representative Ramos.

Cosponsors: Representatives Hagan, R., Henne, Adams, J., Young, Yuko, Ashford, Milkovich, Letson.

To amend section 4301.01 and to enact section 4301.71 of the Revised Code to increase the legally permitted alcohol content of beer and to generally prohibit the inclusion of caffeine or other stimulants in beer containing more than 12% of alcohol by volume.

H. B. No. 357-Representative Ramos.

Cosponsors: Representatives Pillich, Hagan, R., Foley, Phillips, Fende, Antonio, Letson, Murray, Weddington.

To enact section 9.662 of the Revised Code to require JobsOhio and state agencies offering economic development assistance to obtain Controlling Board approval before providing economic development assistance to a person who, at or near the time of receiving the assistance, relocates employment

positions from one taxing district to another or eliminates positions at an existing location.

Said bills were considered the first time.
