INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 384-Representatives Driehaus, Pillich.

To amend section 2903.13 of the Revised Code to increase to a felony of the fifth degree the penalty for committing assault against an Ohio transit system bus operator or maintenance worker or a contracted employee performing those services for an Ohio transit system.

Said bill was considered the first time.
