INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

H. B. No. 403-Representative Hagan, R.

Cosponsors: Representatives Foley, Ramos, Pillich, Yuko, Letson, Antonio, Gerberry, Lundy, Phillips, Murray.

To enact sections 9.242 and 9.662 of the Revised Code to require that all labor and services performed under any contract for goods or services paid for with state funds be performed within the United States, that all labor affected by state-funded economic development assistance be labor within the United States, and that all services performed as a result of such economic development assistance be performed within the United States.

Said bill was considered the first time.
