INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 276-Senator Hite.

To amend sections 185.01, 185.03, 185.05, 2105.35, 2108.40, 2133.211, 3719.06, 4730.06, 4730.09, 4730.38, 4730.39, 4730.40, 4730.41, 4730.42, 4730.44, 4730.45, 4755.48, 4755.481, 4765.01, 4765.35, 4765.36, 4765.37, 4765.38, 4765.39, 4765.49, and 4765.51, to enact sections 4730.411 and 5111.0216, and to repeal section 4730.401 of the Revised Code to modify the laws governing physician assistants.

S. B. No. 277-Senator Skindell.

Cosponsors: Senators Cafaro, Turner, Tavares, Sawyer.

To amend sections 124.14 and 3924.01 and to enact sections 3965.01 to 3965.14 of the Revised Code to establish the Ohio Health Benefit Exchange Agency and to establish the Ohio Health Benefit Exchange Program consisting of an exchange for individual coverage and a Small Business Health Options Program.
