INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 137-Senator Stewart.

Cosponsors: Senators Seitz, Wilson.

To amend sections 1513.07 and 1513.073 of the Revised Code to revise the coal mining laws regarding permit application and set-back requirements.

S. B. No. 138-Senator Hughes.

Cosponsors: Senators Stewart, Widener.

To amend section 5747.113 and to enact section 173.041 of the Revised Code to allow taxpayers to contribute a portion of their income tax refunds to the Alzheimer's Association.

S. B. No. 139-Senator Hughes.

Cosponsors: Senators Schaffer, Seitz, Patton.

To amend sections 4123.291, 4125.01, 4125.02, 4125.03, 4125.05, 4125.07, 4125.08, 4141.24, and 5747.07 and to enact sections 4125.041, 4125.042, 4125.051, 4125.10, and 4125.11 of the Revised Code to establish certain financial capacity requirements for professional employer organizations, clarify rights and liabilities of professional employer organizations and client employers, and make other changes to the professional employer organization law.

S. B. No. 140-Senators Bacon, Skindell.

Cosponsors: Senators Manning, Sawyer, Turner, Brown, Tavares, Oelslager.

To enact section 2927.28 of the Revised Code to require the inclusion of a bittering agent in engine coolant and antifreeze.
