**INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

**S. B. No. 150**-Senator Hughes.

Cosponsor: Senator Grendell.

To enact section 4909.181 of the Revised Code to limit recovery of rate-case expenses for certain water-works and sewage disposal system companies.

**S. B. No. 151**-Senator LaRose.

Cosponsors: Senators Bacon, Wagoner, Seitz, Jones, Grendell.

To amend sections 3109.04 and 3109.051 of the Revised Code regarding child custody and visitation rights of parents called to active military service.

**OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS**

Pursuant to Senate Rule No. 54, the following resolution was offered:

**S. R. No. 64**-Senator Niehaus.

Honoring the Ohio Military Hall of Fame on its twelfth annual induction ceremony.
