INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 152-Senator Kearney.

Cosponsors: Senators Cafaro, Turner, Smith, Brown, Skindell.

To amend section 5101.802 of the Revised Code to extend from 36 months to 60 months the period over which permanency incentive payments may be made to a child's kinship caregiver.

S. B. No. 153-Senator Kearney.

Cosponsors: Senators Cafaro, Turner, Smith, Brown, Skindell, Sawyer.

To amend section 2151.33 of the Revised Code to require a public children services agency that receives temporary custody of a child to exercise due diligence to notify the child's adult relatives.

S. B. No. 154-Senator Smith.

Cosponsor: Senator Schiavoni.

To amend sections 4510.01 and 4511.093 and to enact sections 4508.022 and 4511.204 of the Revised Code to prohibit driving a vehicle while using an electronic wireless communication device to write, send, or read a text-based communication and to establish the violation as a secondary traffic offense.
