INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 210-Senator Burke.

Cosponsors: Senators Bacon, Kearney, Seitz, Widener, Patton.

To amend section 1533.10 of the Revised Code to exempt an applicant for a hunting license who is an active, reserve, or honorably discharged member of the armed forces or an active duty or retired law enforcement officer from completing a hunter education and conservation course in order to obtain the license.

OFFERING OF RESOLUTIONS

Senator Coley offered the following joint resolution:

S. J. R. No. 2-Senator Coley.

Cosponsors: Senators Burke, Patton, Schaffer, Grendell, Jones, Balderson.

Applying to the Congress of the United States pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution to call a constitutional convention for proposing amendments.

The question being, "Shall the joint resolution, **S. J. R. No. 2**, be adopted?"

On the motion of Senator Balderson, **S. J. R. No. 2**, was referred to the Committee on Rules and Reference.

Pursuant to Senate Rule No. 54, the following resolution was offered:

S. R. No. 126-Senator Patton.

Honoring Donovan Robertson as the 2010-2011 Gatorade Ohio Boys Track and Field Athlete of the Year.

The question being, "Shall the resolution listed under the President's prerogative be adopted?"
