INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 384-Senator Jordan.

Cosponsor: Senator Schaffer.

To amend section 5747.02 and to enact section 101.88 of the Revised Code to establish a Joint Committee on Government Efficiency that, on or before August 1, 2014, must issue a report recommending the elimination or consolidation of state agencies and proposing an income tax rate reduction corresponding to the savings projected from its recommendations.
