INTRODUCTION AND FIRST CONSIDERATION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced and considered the first time:

S. B. No. 242-Senator Patton.

Cosponsor: Senator Seitz.

To amend section 4928.65 of the Revised Code to specify that renewable energy resources do not have to be converted to electricity to receive renewable energy credits.

S. B. No. 243-Senator Hughes.

Cosponsor: Senator Wagoner.

To amend sections 5502.21 and 5502.41, to enact new section 5502.29 and section 3345.042, and to repeal section 5502.29 of the Revised Code to modify the laws governing the Intrastate Mutual Aid Compact.

S. B. No. 244-Senator Kearney.

Cosponsors: Senators Skindell, Turner.

To amend section 4503.102 to require the Registrar of Motor Vehicles and all deputy registrars to accept credit and debit cards for transactions of more than ten dollars.

S. B. No. 245-Senator Hughes.

To amend section 4517.05 of the Revised Code to establish mandatory training for used motor vehicle dealers.

S. B. No. 246-Senator Bacon.

To amend sections 3905.01, 3905.06, and 3905.40 and to enact section 3905.062 of the Revised Code to establish requirements and procedures for issuing portable electronics insurance.
