REPORTS OF STANDING AND SELECT COMMITTEES

The standing committee on Ways and Means and Economic Development, to which was referred **H. B. No. 167**-Representatives Derickson, Mallory, et al., having had the same under consideration, reports it back with the following amendments and recommends its passage when so amended.

After line 929, insert:

"Section 4. This act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety. The reason for such necessity is to allow taxpayers to benefit from the income tax deduction authorized by this act as soon as possible, thereby providing a more immediate reduction in the cost of attending college for certain lower-income students. Therefore, this act shall go into immediate effect."

In line 5 of the title, after "student" insert ", and to declare an emergency"
