The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 424-Representatives Bishoff, Hackett.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Derickson, Milkovich, Reece, Terhar.

To amend section 4113.99 and to enact sections 4113.35 to 4113.39 of the Revised Code to prohibit employers and educational institutions from requiring an employee, applicant, student, or prospective student to provide access to any personal Internet account of the employee, applicant, student, or prospective student.

H. B. No. 425-Representative Rosenberger.

Cosponsors: Representatives Green, Grossman, Boose, Hackett, Duffey, Gerberry, Stebelton, Ruhl, Ramos, Perales, Barborak, Mallory, Pillich, Derickson, Strahorn, Reece, Scherer, Lundy, Maag, Sprague.

To enact section 5533.053 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of United States Route 23, within Pike County only, as the "Captain Everett 'Butch' Keaton, Vietnam, SSM and BSM with OLC PH, Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 426-Representatives Barborak, Pillich.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lundy, Hagan, R., Fedor, Antonio, Ramos, Foley.

To amend section 124.341 of the Revised Code to prohibit an appointing authority from taking disciplinary action against public employees who report a noncriminal law violation or misuse of public resources to the Inspector General.

H. B. No. 427-Representative Budish.

Cosponsors: Representatives Pillich, Lundy, Hagan, R., Williams, Boyd, Foley, Rogers, Ashford, Antonio, Redfern, Fedor, Sheehy.

To amend sections 5537.01, 5537.03, 5537.04, 5537.08, and 5537.13, to enact new section 5537.18, and to repeal section 5537.18 of the Revised Code to expand the authorized use of money in the Infrastructure Fund (derived from proceeds from Ohio Turnpike revenue bonds) to include infrastructure projects that consist of the maintenance or repair of existing infrastructure, and to modify the process for approval of infrastructure projects.

H. B. No. 428-Representative Anielski.

Cosponsors: Representatives Stebelton, Hall, DeVitis, Williams, Celebrezze, Dovilla, Brenner.

To amend section 3311.19 and to enact section 3311.191 of the Revised Code to revise the law regarding terms of office of members of certain joint vocational school district boards of education.

Said bills were considered the first time.
