INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 63-Representatives Cera, O'Brien.

Cosponsors: Representatives Rogers, Hagan, R.

To amend section 5751.98 and to enact section 5751.55 of the Revised Code to establish a nonrefundable commercial activity tax credit for companies involved in horizontal well drilling or related oil and gas production services that hire Ohio residents or dislocated workers who have enrolled in or completed a federally registered apprenticeship program.

H. B. No. 64-Representative Cera.

Cosponsors: Representatives Rogers, Hood.

To amend sections 1548.20, 4503.13, and 4519.68 of the Revised Code to provide that if a secured party does not convey to the owner of a motor vehicle, watercraft, outboard motor, off-highway motorcycle, or all-purpose vehicle a physical certificate of title after the security interest has been discharged, the owner may obtain one physical certificate of title from a clerk of a court of common pleas at no charge.

H. B. No. 65-Representatives Green, Rosenberger.

Cosponsors: Representatives Retherford, Terhar, Wachtmann, Gonzales, Derickson, Brenner, Butler, Hackett, Becker, Mallory, Maag, McGregor, Ruhl, Brown, Grossman.

To amend section 1533.12 of the Revised Code to allow an individual on active military duty, while on leave or furlough, to hunt deer or wild turkey without procuring a deer or wild turkey permit.

H. B. No. 66-Representatives Antonio, Patmon.

Cosponsors: Representatives Ramos, Foley, Cera, Driehaus, Fedor, Gerberry, Hagan, R., Slesnick, Pillich, Stinziano, Lundy, Strahorn, Patterson, Buchy, Boyce, Phillips, Ruhl, Rogers, Boyd, Anielski, Barborak.

To enact section 5533.921 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 2 in Cuyahoga County as the Governor Richard F. Celeste Shoreway.

Said bills were considered the first time.
