INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 113-Representatives Antonio, Henne.

Cosponsors: Representatives Ramos, Brenner, Hood, Driehaus, Hagan, R., Letson, Stinziano, Milkovich, Boyce, Hackett, Rogers, Cera.

To amend section 3313.603 of the Revised Code to specify that school districts and chartered nonpublic schools may excuse from high school physical education students who participate in a school-sponsored athletic club.

H. B. No. 114-Representative Lynch.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Hayes, Maag, Retherford, Wachtmann.

To amend section 4507.06 of the Revised Code to specify the persons who are not citizens of the United States that are eligible to receive an Ohio driver's license or motorcycle operator's license or endorsement, and to amend the version of section 4507.06 of the Revised Code that is scheduled to take effect January 1, 2017, to continue the provisions of this act on and after that effective date.

H. B. No. 115-Representative Schuring.

To enact section 126.33 of the Revised Code to create the Local Government Bridge Fund for the purpose of providing grants to local governments up to the reduced amount of funds the government received in fiscal years 2012 and 2013 from the Local Government Fund to assist in the implementation of efficiency and cost-saving measures, and to make an appropriation.

Said bills were considered the first time.
