INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 520-Representatives Carney, Patterson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Lundy, Rogers, Boyd, Curtin, Hagan, R., Ashford, Strahorn, O'Brien, Foley, Antonio, Ramos, Gerberry, Fedor, Slesnick.

To amend sections 117.11 and 149.351 and to enact sections 117.102, 149.46, and 3314.031 of the Revised Code regarding audit and record-keeping requirements for community school sponsors and operators.

H. B. No. 521-Representative Cera.

Cosponsor: Representative Fedor.

To amend section 3307.01 of the Revised Code to include in the membership of the State Teachers Retirement System certain teachers performing services entities providing computer-based instruction to students by contract with a school.

H. B. No. 522-Representatives O'Brien, Duffey.

To amend sections 6112.01 and 6112.03 and to enact section 6112.06 of the Revised Code to require notification to a property owner whose property is served by a household sewage treatment system of the construction of a private sewerage system to which the property will be required to connect, and to authorize such a property owner to elect not to connect to the sewerage system under specified conditions.

Said bills were considered the first time.
