The House met pursuant to adjournment.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 531-Representative Gonzales.

Cosponsor: Representative DeVitis.

To amend sections 4730.14, 4731.22, 4731.222, 4731.225, 4731.281, and 4778.06 and to enact sections 4730.252, 4760.133, 4762.133, 4774.133, and 4778.141 of the Revised Code to authorize the State Medical Board to fine certain professionals it regulates for failing to comply with continuing education requirements without suspending the individual's license or certificate to practice, to authorize the Board to fine the professionals it regulates for violating law administered by the Board, and to impose additional terms and conditions for physician certificate restoration.

H. B. No. 532-Representatives Roegner, Reece.

Cosponsors: Representatives Brenner, Lynch, Mallory, Blair, Thompson, Hood, Heard.

To amend sections 2925.01, 4713.01, 4713.02, 4713.03, 4713.06, 4713.07, 4713.08, 4713.081, 4713.082, 4713.09, 4713.10, 4713.13, 4713.14, 4713.141, 4713.16, 4713.17, 4713.20, 4713.21, 4713.22, 4713.24, 4713.25, 4713.26, 4713.28, 4713.30, 4713.31, 4713.34, 4713.35, 4713.36, 4713.37, 4713.39, 4713.41, 4713.42, 4713.44, 4713.45, 4713.48, 4713.55, 4713.56, 4713.57, 4713.58, 4713.59, 4713.60, 4713.61, 4713.62, 4713.63, 4713.64, 4713.641, and 4713.99 and to enact sections 4713.071, 4713.66, and 4713.69 of the Revised Code to make changes to the Cosmetology Licensing Law.

Said bills were considered the first time.

WHEREAS, Am. Sub. S.B. 248 of the 127th General Assembly established the Ohio Military Medal of Distinction to honor Ohioans who have fallen while in the service of the United States; and

WHEREAS, The Ohio General Assembly intends to honor the recipients of the Ohio Military Medal of Distinction in a joint session of the General Assembly convened for that purpose; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That we, the members of the 130th General Assembly of the State of Ohio, shall meet in joint session in the chamber of the House of Representatives on Thursday, May 22, 2014, at 11:15 o'clock a.m., for the purpose of honoring the recipients of the Ohio Military Medal of Distinction and their family members.
