BILLS FOR THIRD CONSIDERATION

H. B. No. 468-Representatives Sears, McGregor.

Cosponsors: Representatives Becker, Hackett, Henne.

To amend sections 505.871, 4501.25, 4505.061, 4738.01, 4738.02, 4738.03, 4738.17, and 4738.99, to enact sections 3937.19, 4738.021, 4738.022, 4738.023, and 4738.031, and to repeal section 4738.18 of the Revised Code relative to salvage motor vehicles and junk motor vehicles, was taken up for consideration the third time.

The question being, "Shall the bill pass?"

Representative Schuring moved that **H. B. No. 468**-Representatives Sears, McGregor, et al., be informally passed and that it be taken up for consideration on: Wednesday, May 14, 2014.

Code to make changes to the renewable energy, energy efficiency, and peak demand reduction requirements and to create a study committee.
