INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 553-Representative Letson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Mallory, Hagan, R.

To enact section 3345.35 of the Revised Code to require state institutions of higher education to donate any interest earned on the presale of athletic event tickets to food banks.

H. B. No. 554-Representative Stinziano.

Cosponsors: Representatives Antonio, Becker, Bishoff, Hagan, R., Phillips, Letson.

To amend sections 3517.13 and 3517.992 of the Revised Code to prohibit a person who holds an elective office and who is a candidate from using public funds to mail to individuals unsolicited applications for absent voter's ballots that contain the name of the candidate or an image of the candidate's signature.

H. B. No. 555-Representatives Rogers, Letson.

Cosponsors: Representatives Mallory, Hagan, R., Antonio, Barborak.

To enact section 5502.391 of the Revised Code to require the Emergency Management Agency to operate the Individual Disaster Relief Pilot Program, to establish the Individual Disaster Relief Fund, and to make an appropriation.

Said bills were considered the first time.
