INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

To enact section 5.2279 of the Revised Code to designate the month of November as "Auto Industry Month."

H. B. No. 195-Representative Redfern.

To enact section 5533.649 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 51 within Ottawa County the "Officer William J. Hetrick Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 196-Representative Redfern.

To enact section 5533.182 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 101 between the municipal corporations of Castalia and Sandusky only, as the "Sfc. Charles L. Adkins Memorial Highway."

H. B. No. 197-Representatives Barnes, Grossman.

Cosponsors: Representatives Antonio, Mallory, Patmon, Schuring, Wachtmann.

To amend sections 2743.51, 2743.59, and 2743.66 and to enact sections 3333.27 and 5111.82 of the Revised Code to award at least twenty-five thousand dollars per year from the court of claims victims of crime fund to any survivor of abduction who was abducted for a period of eight years or more; to award free tuition at any state university or college to any such survivor of abduction; to seek a waiver from the United States Secretary of Health and Human Services for medical assistance to be provided for any such survivor of abduction for the duration of the survivor's lifetime; and to name the provisions of this bill the Michelle Knight, Amanda Berry, and Gina DeJesus Survivors of Abduction Act.

To amend sections 5709.40, 5709.73, 5709.78, and 5709.911 of the Revised Code to establish a procedure by which political subdivisions proposing a tax increment financing (TIF) incentive district are required to provide notice to the record owner of each parcel within the proposed incentive district before adopting the TIF resolution, and to permit such owners to exclude their parcels from the incentive district by submitting a written response.
