### INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bill was introduced:

**H. B. No. 596**-Representative Pelanda.

Cosponsors: Representatives Huffman, Buchy, Blessing.

To amend sections 3107.062, 3107.065, 3107.066, and 3107.99; to amend, for the purpose of adopting a new section number as indicated in parentheses, section 3107.066 (3107.067); and to enact new section 3107.066 of the Revised Code to provide that ineffective promotion of the putative father registry does not relieve a putative father of the consequences of failing to timely register with the putative father registry and to make false registration a first degree misdemeanor.

Said bill was considered the first time.
