The House met pursuant to adjournment.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

INTRODUCTION OF BILLS

The following bills were introduced:

H. B. No. 597-Representatives Thompson, Huffman.

To repeal and replace the Common Core Initiative academic standards and related assessment system.

H. B. No. 598-Representatives Blessing, Driehaus.

Cosponsors: Representatives Beck, Becker, Maag, Mallory, Ramos, Reece, Retherford, Rosenberger.

To amend section 4301.62 and to enact section 4301.82 of the Revised Code to allow municipal corporations with a population of more than 50,000 to create municipal entertainment districts and to exempt persons within such districts from the open container law.

H. B. No. 599-Representative Grossman.

To amend section 4501.21 and to enact section 4503.87 of the Revised Code to create the "I Love Grove City" license plate.

H. B. No. 600-Representatives Beck, Adams, J.

Cosponsors: Representatives Retherford, Brenner.

To amend sections 5739.02, 5741.02, 5741.03, and 5751.03 and to enact sections 5739.20 and 5751.031 of the Revised Code to earmark new Ohio use tax collections by remote sellers for the purposes of paying back amounts borrowed by the state from the federal government to issue unemployment benefits and reducing the rates of the sales and use tax and commercial activity tax.

H. B. No. 601-Representatives Beck, Adams, J.

Cosponsors: Representatives Retherford, Romanchuk, Brenner.

To amend sections 5725.33 and 5747.01 and to enact section 5747.014 of the Revised Code to authorize taxpayers to continue applying certain expiring federal tax provisions in calculating Ohio income tax, and to declare an emergency.

H. B. No. 602-Representatives Beck, Adams, J.

Cosponsors: Representatives Retherford, Brenner.

To amend section 5747.98 and to enact section 5747.78 of the Revised Code to authorize an income tax credit for the amount of sales tax included in the cost of essential post-disaster goods and services purchased by disaster victims.

H. B. No. 603-Representatives Beck, Adams, J.

Cosponsors: Representatives Retherford, Brenner, Thompson.

To amend section 5739.01 of the Revised Code to exempt the sale of internet access used in business from sales and use tax.

Said bills were considered the first time.
