To enact section 4503.434 of the Revised Code to establish the "Distinguished Flying Cross" license plate.

H. B. No. 608-Representative Lundy.

Cosponsors: Representatives Rogers, Hagan, R., Fedor, Foley.

To amend section 1321.99 and to enact section 1321.90 of the Revised Code to prohibit any person from making an auto title loan in Ohio.

H. B. No. 609-Representatives Anielski, Kunze.

Cosponsors: Representatives Beck, Budish, Butler, Conditt, Duffey, Grossman, Phillips, Ruhl, Terhar.

To enact section 3345.37 of the Revised Code with regard to suicide prevention programs at state institutions of higher education.
